Volunteer Positions Needed

LEADER

Responsible for primary control of the horse during programs, attention on the horse, not the rider. May assist rider with verbal cues, verbal support and encouragement. Instructor will give direction.

SIDE WALKER

Responsible for walking beside the horse and rider to give physical or moral support to the rider. May give verbal or physical cues, reminders and encouragement to the rider. Side walkers' attention is on the rider, not the horse.

GROOMER

Gets a list of horses and tack to be used for that lesson from the instructor. Responsible for taking the horses out of their stalls, putting them on the crossties, grooming, picking hooves, and tacking them appropriately for the lesson.

BARN VOLUNTEERS

With the assistance of stable management, responsibilities vary according to need. These responsibilities are cleaning stalls, water buckets & troughs, restocking hay, restocking grain room, cleaning tack, grounds upkeep, grooming horses, bathing horses and any other daily operations of barn maintenance. This opportunity is also designed for individuals who would like to further their interest and education in stable management, horse ownership, and knowledge of horses in general.

OFFICE

Under the direction of the Program Director and Office Manager, office volunteers serve to assist in the administrative functions of the organization including; copying, data entry, mailing, and answering phones.

MAINTENANCE

Under the direction of the Program Director and Grounds Committee, the maintenance volunteers perform routine repairs and improvements on the facility and grounds.

FUNDRAISING

Working with the Volunteer Coordinator and Project Managers, these volunteers plan and staff special events which direct the community's attention and support to Lothlorien.
